Music	Fade In
Introduction	Along the Cotswold Canals. Welcome to Jubilee Bridge, one of the places on the Canals Trail. This is one of a series of recordings made local people you can listen to at different places along the Cotswold canals.
Music	Fade Out
Narrator	This section of the canal is perhaps one of the most peaceful. It's known as the Golden Valley and is a haven for wildlife.
Narrator	If you walk from here towards Stroud you'll come to Griffin Mill's lock where Howard Beard fished for newts when he was young
Howard Beard	I've cut first part of clip as it's talking about ham mill not Griffin Mill I remember lying on the stonework at the edge of the lock and reaching down into the water, amongst the water weed to try and catch newts and that was really quite exciting. I always enjoyed being on the canal.
Narrator	If you are looking for a change of scene and, and perhaps a bit of refreshment, Chris Balodis recommends a little detour from the towpath
Chris Balodis	Head to Jubilee Bridge which you know you can cross over and walk up towards the common, to Rodborough common, and obviously the favourite place for dog walkers which is you know the ice cream place up on Rodborough common Winstones ice cream
